

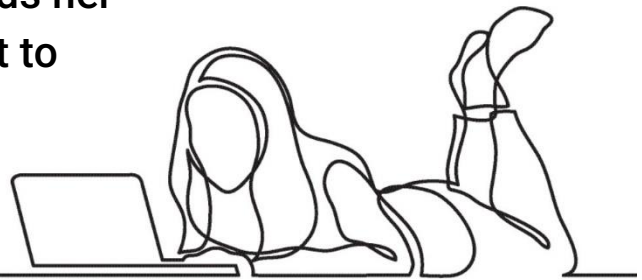

What advice would you give to her?

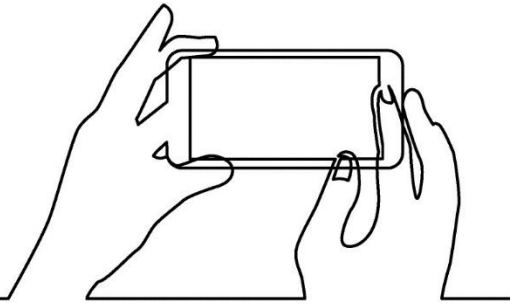

What advice would you give to him?

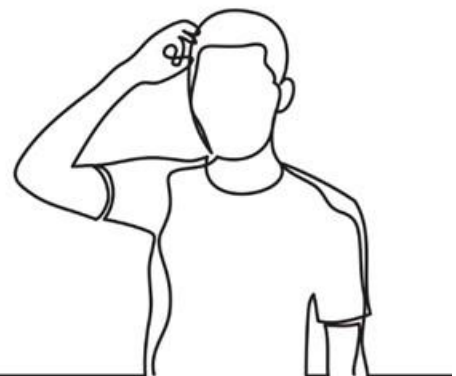
Gabby has been chatting to a friend she made online. The friend is really funny and makes her laugh. Then the friend suggests they meet up in the park.
